Many thanks for the copy of the first part of your new list - and for the plastic cover - very useful! In leafing it through, I note the 8 yrs. 3 months for Bennett's Wallaby at Philadelphia. This seems very short for a species so commonly kept - perhaps people haven't bothered. We have August 29, 1946 to February 8, 1957 for the species but even that isn't much! Our Euro born April 14, 1941, which you list as S.A., died November 23, 1960 - still pretty good!

I don't see how you can go wrong in following Allen for Cercopithecus. Hill will have his own ideas about Macaca and Presbytis
but until he publishes Ellerman and Morrison-Scott are authorities
that can't be over-looked. There is also Chasen for the island
forms, if you can figure them out!
